



### **Local News Brief**

The Uwharrie National Forest stretches across North Carolina's Montgomery, Randolph and Davidson counties. Known for its proximity to the first big US gold strike in 1799, the forest is making the news with release of a Bigfoot video shot in 2010.

Shot by Michael Greene of Salisbury NC, the video shows two moving figures among the trees. His footage, a thermal video available at www.bushloper.net, is being taken seriously. Animal Planet came to North Carolina in February 2011 to film the search for Bigfoot, reportedly part of a series they will air Fall 2011.

Mr. Greene's video of Bigfoot casually hanging out in the NC forest has also reached the Bigfoot Field Researchers Organization (BFRO), a group that took part in the recent search. Their site, and recent bigfoot sightings in NC, are listed atwww.bfro.net.

### Not Lions, Tigers or Bears So Far
