Local News Brief

January 19, 2011 a triangle-shaped unidentified flying object (UFO) was spotted—and video taped— above Garner, NC. Not long after dark on that date, the witness saw an object in the sky near his home. He could not get his camcorder set up on a tripod, as the object disappeared quickly. The video he shot shows a fast-moving craft moving around a house, with several lights surrounding it. The witness stated that the object made no sound, so could not be a helicopter, and that it looked like a "Battlestar Gallactica" fighter plane.

According to the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON), more than 30 UFO sightings in North Carolina have been reported since September 2010.



The Bad News...

Wildfire Dangers

The North Carolina Division of Forest Resources issued warnings in February 2011 due to increased risk of wildfires. Residents of the state were warned not to burn outdoors due to high winds and dry air.

"Red flag warnings" and "fire danger statements" were issued for the entire state of North Carolina for a period during February. The most severe is the "red flag warning", which means that critical fire weather conditions are occurring or will occur soon. Fire weather conditions include strong winds, low relative humidity and warm temperatures.

Wild Weather

Experts at the National Weather Service reported a tornado hit Stantonsburg in Wilson County on Sunday, March 6th. Damage from the tornado was said to be minor.

A large storm with strong winds swept Wilson, Wake, and surrounding counties that day, dropping significant rain. The winds wreaked havoc through parts of Wilson, Wake, Franklin, Chatham, Sampson, Halifax, and Warren counties.
