Heard of the Guinness World Records? The North Carolina School of Science & Math in Durham NC went after a Guinness record for the "largest food drive at a single location in 24 hours by a non-profit organization". This was the school's second attempt, and this time they set the record!

March 5th the school held their fast-paced food drive to benefit the Food Bank of Central & Eastern NC. The food drive results broke the Guinness World Records by gathering a total of 559,885 lbs of food. Not too shabby for one day's work!


