

Local News Briefs

The Office of the Governor issued notification on April 17th that Gov. Bev Perdue "has declared a state of emergency for North Carolina following storms that generated tornadoes across the state. The declaration puts the state's emergency management plan into action and provides access to resources needed to aid communities affected by the storms."

The Governor also issued an order that made it possible for utility workers to work more hours repairing power lines, by temporarily suspending the restrictions on their work hours. The same order temporarily waives the restriction on truck driver driving hours, allowing them additional hours to transport supplies to affected communities or truck out debris.

Later that same week, the Governor received a federal disaster declaration from the US government. This gives access to federal loans and grants for residents and businesses impacted by the storms.

The Governor is also awaiting response on a request to U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Tom Vilsack for an agricultural disaster declaration. This would augment state programs available from county Farm Service offices which helps farmers with debris removal to aid replanting, or helps recoup losses of livestock and poultry.

The Employment Security Commission of North Carolina released a report April 27th that the unemployment rates decreased in 99 of North Carolina's 100 counties in the previous month.

"Unemployment rates declined in nearly every county in March," said ESC Chairman Lynn R. Holmes. "We are beginning to see more counties drop below a rate of ten percent unemployment. This reflects the commitment by Gov. Perdue and our workforce partners to grow jobs in our state, and this agency remains focused on putting people back to work."
