Local News Briefs

Former Mayor of Rocky Mount, Fred Turnage, died on August 1st after a long battle with pancreatic cancer. Born in Rocky Mount in 1936, he attended Rocky Mount City Schools and Wake Forest University. Turnage was admitted to the North Carolina State Bar in 1961 and practiced law with a Rocky Mount firm. He later had a private law practice.

Mr. Turnage served with the Rocky Mount City Council, and in 1972 he was named Mayor Pro Tem. A year later, he was elected Mayor of Rocky Mount — the youngest person to be Mayor. He served as mayor until December 2007, after serving the city for 34 years.

The Good News... School Supplies and More

It has been a hot summer, hopefully one filled with fun and memories for local families. Now it's time to get back to school, which starts August 25th for Wilson County Schools, Franklin County Schools, Nash-Rocky Mount Public Schools, and Edgecombe County Public Schools.

Before the kids head back to class, Wilson area families can pick up free school supplies at the "Back 2 School Summit" August 20th. From noon to 6pm, families can come to Adventure World Skate & Fun Center In Wilson for this free event. In addition to passing out bags of school supplies to several hundred local children (all grade levels), there will be music, inflatables, basketball, free pizza, snacks, snow cones, and drinks. A face painter will also be on hand. Admission is free, and skating from 4-6pm is \$3 — or \$1 if you pick up a ticket in advance at the skating rink. The Bad News... Hepatitis A Vaccination Update: Close to 2,700 Doses Given

Update released on August 11th: The Cumberland County Public Health Department has administered almost 2,700 doses of Hepatitis A immunizations since Tuesday morning to individuals who may have been exposed through an employee at a local restaurant. By 3 p.m. Thursday, the department had given 570 shots during the clinic's third day. On Tuesday and Wednesday, an estimated 2,100 people were vaccinated.

Residents of other counties should check with their local Public Health Department to see if they have the Hepatitis A vaccine.

Military personnel, their family members and retirees can go to Womack Army Medical Center on Fort Bragg for the immunization.

Deputy Health Director Rodney Jenkins wants the public to understand that there has not been a Hepatitis A outbreak in Cumberland County, but that the Health Department is working to protect citizens who may have been exposed to the disease through an Olive Garden employee diagnosed with the illness.

"We are only aware of one case of illness," he said, referring to the restaurant employee. Getting the vaccine within the first 14 days of exposure will significantly reduce the chance of getting Hepatitis A.

Starting on Friday [August 12th], only individuals who visited the Olive Garden at 234 North McPherson Church Road anytime on July 29, 31 and Aug. 1, 2 and 8 should contact the Health Department to receive a free injection of Hepatitis A immune globulin or vaccine because there is a 14-day window when the vaccine is effective.



It is the first day of the new school year and you're driving your daughter to school. She is going to middle school for the first time, and you want to walk her in and help her pick up her schedule and find her new classroom.

You arrive and walk into the school. The two of you run into a good friend of yours by the office, as your friend's daughter is also starting middle school. The girls begin chatting and catching up.

You hadn't seen your friend over the summer. When you last saw her in June, she had just started dating a man and had been excited about the summer break to do some "family" things. She seems embarrassed, but also happy to see you and talks a little as you wait in the school office. You quickly find that your usually perky friend is not so perky. And you can tell that she has a big black eye, even though she's tried to cover it with makeup.

After the girls are checked in and off to class, you pull your friend aside and ask her how things have been going. She says their summer was fine. Then she says she needs to go because her boyfriend is waiting in the car and she doesn't want to keep him waiting.

While you've only had a short time to catch up, you have a strong feeling that something is terribly wrong in your friend's life. 

A Little Local History

Fort Macon

Drive a little more than two hours from Wilson, Rocky Mount, or Zebulon to Atlantic Beach. Then, make a left and drive up East Fort Macon Road until you run out of road. You'll be at Fort Macon State Park, ready to explore an amazing "local" structure: Fort Macon.

Construction of Fort Macon began in 1826, according to www.ncparks.gov, the website of the NC Division of Parks and Recreation. Five-sided, made of brick and stone, Fort Macon's layout includes 26 vaulted rooms enclosed by thick outer walls.

The first troops occupied the fort starting in 1834. The fort was manned by different armies over the years, through multiple wars, even serving as a coaling station and a prison. For some time, it was even abandoned.

In 1923, Fort Macon and the surrounding reservation were sold for one dollar to NC for use as a public park.

After restoration by the Civilian Conservation Corps, Fort Macon State Park to opened in 1936. For part of the 1940s, the US Army occupied the park, returning it to the state following World War II.

Walking through the fort, visitors can view exhibits showing life in prior times. They can also scale the steps to the grassy "roof" and look over the surrounding walls and beyond. A family can easily pass several hours exploring Fort Macon and the surrounding trails and visitor's center.
