## Citizens Pelted with Flour & Eggs in Annual Festival

Visitors to Ibi, Spain on the last Friday in December may have seen quite a sight! An annual festival includes a traditional “food fight” with eggs and flour thrown by town residents.

Each year, the festival of *Els Enfarinats* starts with one group of townspeople “taking over the town” and declaring bizarre ordinances. Passersby may be accused of violating the ordinances and fines levied. Later in the day, a different group “takes back the town” and restores order. Collected “fines” go to local charities. Fireworks and the food fight round out the festival day.

## Calling NC Artists to Largest Juried Competition in the SE

*Carolina’s Got Art!* (CGA!) has launched a call to artists to their annual juried arts competition. Open to NC and SC artists only, \$15,000 in cash and prizes will be awarded to winning artists. Notable art critic, Lance Esplund, of *Bloomberg* and *The Wall Street Journal*, is serving as a 2013 juror.

CGA! accepts most mediums including paintings, photography, sculptures, woven pieces, and ceramics. Of the ten 2010 winners, five won prizes for sculpture or ceramic work.

## Comet Visible in Sky Throughout 2013

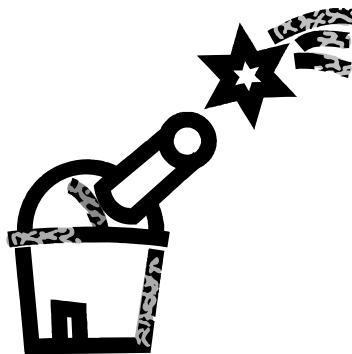
A comet is coming in 2013 that will be bright enough for viewing with the naked eye. This object may be seen in the coming months, turning into a spectacular show by Fall.

“C/2012 S1 (ISON)” is a comet found through images taken September 21st. It was discovered by two observers with access to Russia’s International Scientific Optical Network (ISON) reflector telescope and named after the observatory.

This comet, being referred to as *ISON* for short, is predicted to be brighter than a full moon in the sky.

Now only visible through large telescopes, as it gets nearer to our sun it will be easier to see in the sky. ISON may be watched through binoculars by late Summer, and with the naked eye by Fall. Some predict that the comet’s tail may be viewed as it travels across the sky at its nearest approach.

Even without expensive equipment, this bright object may be observed. It should make for some fun and educational evenings sky-watching.

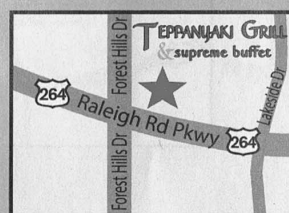

## Carmike 10-Wilson Movie Review of the Issue

For this issue, we reviewed *The Hobbit: An Unexpected Journey*. This film is the first of three films retelling the story of Bilbo Baggins. The films follow the story line of J.R.R. Tolkien's 1937 children's novel, *The Hobbit*, or *There and Back Again*.



This first film in the Hobbit trilogy begins where the book begins: "In a hole in the ground there lived a hobbit." The first part of the movie takes place at the home of Bilbo Baggins, Bag End in The Shire.

Tolkien's book includes many songs woven in with the adventures. Likewise, *The Hobbit: An Unexpected Journey* includes singing of songs.

At almost 3 hours in length, the film is full of many action scenes. Fast and furious action is mixed with intriguing scenes like the one between Bilbo and Gollum. There are violent battle scenes in line with what was seen in the *Lord of the Rings* trilogy of movies. Use those films as a guide when deciding whether to take your children to see *The Hobbit*.

Despite this film being created from a book separate from the *Lord of The Rings* book series, Director Jackson has used the same look and feel (and many of the same actors) as were used in the *Lord of The Rings* movies. Mr. Bilbo Baggins, as played by actor Martin Freeman, is endearing, much like the character as written in Tolkien's book. Several scenes seem to be included to tie into Jackson's other movies, for which *The Hobbit* is a prequel.

With a 3D version available, and Director Peter Jackson using an unheard of 48 frames per second film speed, this first part of Bilbo's story can be quite a viewing experience, as well as a great adventure story.
